SEC Chairman to Give First Major Speech Since Confirmation

Securities and Exchange Commission Chairman Jay Clayton will address the Economic Club of New York July 12—his first major public speech since joining the agency in May.

He is expected to talk about his plans for the agency, including possible next steps.

In other SEC events, senior special counsel Christopher Mulligan will speak at the Practising Law Institute's Private Equity Forum in New York July 10. Mulligan will discuss the agency's priorities regarding private equity fund managers, including compliance issues and the examination process.

Capitol Hill On the Hill, the House Financial Services Capital Markets Subcommittee will hold a hearing July 13 on the impact of the fiduciary rule on capital markets. The same panel will hold a hearing July 14 on the structure of the fixed income markets.

No witnesses have been announced for either hearing.

Federal Reserve Chair Janet Yellen will give the Semiannual Monetary Policy Report in front of the House Financial Services Committee July 12 and the Senate Banking Committee July 13.
