Insulin Makers, PBMs to Testify Before House Panel Next Week

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Three insulin manufacturers and the three biggest pharmacy benefit managers will be in Washington next week for a hearing before the House Energy and Commerce's oversight subcommittee, according to Democratic Rep. Diana DeGette, chairwoman of the subcommittee.

- Committee says Eli Lilly, Novo Nordisk and Sanofi are the three insulin manufacturers that serve the U.S. market while CVS Health, Express Scripts and UnitedHealth are the three PBMs that cover about 70% of all prescription claims in the U.S.
- Express Scripts is owned by Cigna
